Brief

Wuhan boasts unique customs and culture. Its dialect is straightforward, with phrases like "youbanyan" (meaning "banyan") conveying a bold and forthright tone. The city boasts a rich culinary scene, including mouth-watering dishes like hot dry noodles, fresh fish noodle soup, pork ribs and lotus root soup, and Wuchang fish. Han embroidery, one of the three renowned embroidery styles of Jiangnan, boasts exquisite needlework and vibrant colors. Hubei drum music, performed in the Huangpi dialect, offers a lingering charm. During festivals, the Lantern Festival dragon dance and the Dragon Boat Festival dragon boat race are bustling with activity. Guiyuan Temple also boasts the fascinating custom of counting the Arhats.

Sights



Located on Snake Hill in Wuchang, Wuhan, the Yellow Crane Tower was built in the second year of the Huangwu reign of the Wu Kingdom during the Three Kingdoms period. It is one of the three most famous towers in the Jiangnan region. After repeated construction and destruction, it was rebuilt in 1985. Its five-story eaves are renowned for its poems by poets such as Cui Hao, and it is a national 5A-level scenic spot.

The Hubei Provincial Museum houses over 260,000 pieces of art, including ten of its most iconic treasures, including the Zenghouyi chime bells and the Sword of Goujian, King of Yue. The new museum, opening in 2021, boasts a larger exhibition area and incorporates high-tech elements, making it a prime destination for appreciating the charm of ancient Chu culture.

Transportation

- Take bus No. 14, 552, 578, 701, or 402 to the Provincial Museum on Donghu Road (bus stop), and walk about 300 meters to the destination.



A National 5A-level scenic area, it encompasses four distinctive scenic areas: Tingtao, Moshan, Luoyan, and Chuidi. Each area offers leisure, flower viewing, birdwatching, and mountain hiking. The 101.98-kilometer East Lake Greenway connects these scenic areas, along with the Provincial Museum and Botanical Garden. This blend of nature and culture makes it a landmark ecological and leisure destination in Wuhan.

Qingchuan Pavilion, nestled on Guishan Mountain in Hanyang, faces the Yangtze River and Yellow Crane Tower across the river. It's considered one of the "Three Holy Lands of Chu." Named after a line in a poem by Cui Hao, the existing buildings, a reconstruction from the 1980s, comprise Qingchuan Pavilion and the Yuji Palace.

⑤ Wuhan Maya Beach Water Park 武汉玛雅海滩水公园

Wuhan Maya Beach Water Park, a large-scale water theme park in central China, opened in 2012. Designed by a leading institution, it blends Mayan civilization with modern entertainment. Spanning 160,000 square meters, it boasts 17 world-leading attractions. The Maya Carnival, held during the summer months, is a popular destination for visitors seeking water fun and a relaxing escape from the heat.

⑥ Gude Temple 古德寺



Gude Temple, named after the ancient spirit and the desire to spread virtue, is modeled after the Ananda Temple in Myanmar. It is one of only two remaining Buddhist buildings of this style in the world, possessing a unique blend of religious, architectural, and cultural significance. Hidden among the city's skyscrapers, it was once a hidden gem, unknown even to many Wuhan residents.

⑦ Jiangnan Road Pedestrian Street 江汉路步行街



Jiangnan Road Pedestrian Street, located in the heart of Hankou, is known as "the world's best pedestrian street." It boasts a vibrant mix of shops and snacks, offering both shopping and leisure opportunities. With over a dozen modern-style buildings remaining, it's a veritable "Museum of 20th-Century Architecture."

⑧ Wuhan Yangtze River Bridge 武汉长江大桥



Wuhan Yangtze River Bridge, the first bridge across the Yangtze River, was completed in 1957. Spanning Snake Mountain in Wuchang and Turtle Mountain in Hanyang, it is a landmark in Wuhan. The bridge consists of two levels (an upper level for highway and a lower level for railway), and the bridgeheads feature both ethnic and Russian styles. Access is by foot or by elevator, and the surrounding area is home to scenic spots such as the Yellow Crane Tower and Qingchuan Pavilion.

⑨ Wuhan University 武汉大学



Wuhan University, a key university under the "Double First-Class" and "985 Project" programs, is located in Wuchang, Wuhan, surrounded by East Lake and Luojia Mountain. It is known as "China's Most Beautiful University." The campus's 26 palatial-style ancient buildings, a blend of Chinese and Western styles,

are a true gem and designated a National Key Cultural Relics Protection Site.

⑩ Tanhualin 昙华林



Tanhualin, a historic street in Wuchang boasting over 600 years of history, developed a diverse architectural style after 1861, thanks to the intermingling of Chinese and foreign residents. Today, it's a cultural landmark in Wuhan, where young artists flock to take photos and enjoy coffee. The street celebrates the city's past with its old buildings, while historical relics like Renji Hospital and Qian Jibo's former residence await exploration.

Eating

Wuhan's culinary scene is diverse and enticing, embodying the vibrant atmosphere of the Jiangnan city. Hot dry noodles are a signature dish of the city's cuisine, featuring chewy noodles coated in a rich, fragrant sesame paste. Tossed with diced radish and pickled beans, they create a simple yet memorable experience. The three-fresh tofu skin is a standout, boasting a golden, crispy outer layer of egg skin and a soft, glutinous rice interior. The filling, stir-fried with diced meat, mushrooms, and bamboo shoots, creates a rich, layered experience with a delicious texture.

Jingwu duck neck is renowned for its spicy and numbing flavor. The meat is firm and chewy, becoming increasingly fragrant with each bite, a truly irresistible delight. There's also pork rib and lotus root soup, featuring tender pork ribs slowly simmered in a rich, warming and nourishing broth.

◆ Pork Ribs and Lotus Root Soup 排骨藕汤

Caidian lotus root and pork ribs are slowly stewed over low heat. The lotus root soup is thick and the aroma of meat and lotus root blends together. It is a classic soup on the table of Wuhan people.



◆ Spicy Enough to Jump 辣得跳

A must-try dish in Wuhan! Selected bullfrogs are cooked with a variety of chilies for a spicy kick that's sure to make your taste buds jump. While the spiciness is intense, the delicious flavor and tender texture will keep you coming back for more.



◆ Fish Head Rice Soup 鱼头泡饭

Wuhan's signature fish head rice soup uses fresh bighead carp to slowly cook into a milky white soup. The fish is tender and not fishy, and the soup is fresh and rich. Mix it with rice to fully absorb the flavor. Every bite is the ultimate fusion of freshness and fragrance.



◆ Braised Crayfish 油焖小龙虾

Braised in a secret sauce, it's bright red and spicier, with a rich, spicy kick. The shrimp are firm and chewy, soaking up the sauce for a rich, savory flavor, making it a popular summer delicacy.



◆ Hot Noodles with Sesame Paste 热干面

Hot dry noodles are the soul of Wuhan breakfast! These alkaline noodles are chewy and smooth, tossed with rich sesame paste and topped with diced radish and pickled beans. The aroma is so fragrant it's a surefire way to awaken the morning energy of this city.



◆ Three Fresh Bean Curd 三鲜豆皮

Spread a thin pancake with mung bean and rice batter, then fill it with glutinous rice, diced meat, mushrooms, and bamboo shoots, and pan-fry until golden brown. It's crispy on the outside and glutinous on the inside, with a rich, fresh, and fragrant aroma.



◆ Noodle Nest 面窝

In Wuhan's breakfast scene, mianwo (rice wok) is a must-try. Made from a fine mixture of rice and soybeans, seasoned with chopped green onions and salt, it's scooped into a specially crafted round iron ladle, leaving a hollow in the middle, and deep-fried in hot oil. Once golden and puffed, with crispy edges and a soft center, it exudes a rich aroma of rice and soybeans, making it a truly authentic mianwo. Whether paired with hot dry noodles, fish paste soup, or enjoyed on its own for breakfast, the crispy exterior and soft interior, with a salty and fragrant flavor, are both filling and satisfying, a flavor etched into the morning memories of Wuhan residents.
