Everyday life is filled with the graceful rhythm of Suzhou's pingtan and the quaint simplicity of Nanjing's Jinling Carved Scriptures, a beautiful blend of millennia-old cultural heritage and the mundane world of everyday life.

Humble Administrator's Garden 拙政园



The Humble Administrator's Garden, a renowned garden in Suzhou, is centered around water and boasts a diverse array of rockery and courtyards, lush with flowers and trees. Along with the Summer Palace, it's considered one of China's Four Great Gardens and a World Cultural Heritage site. Divided into three sections, the garden offers a unique scene at every step, including the exquisite "North Temple and Pagoda" and "Little Rainbow Bridge." The garden is accessible year-round and features numerous flower exhibitions.

② Confucius Temple 夫子庙



Nanjing's Confucius Temple, built during the Song Dynasty and located on the north bank of the Qinhuai River, is one of China's four great Confucian temples and a central feature of the Qinhuai Scenic Belt. The complex consists of the Confucian Temple and the Imperial Academy. The Dacheng Hall houses a statue of Confucius and depictions of his sacred relics. Visitors can also enjoy folk crafts and the Spring Festival Lantern Festival.

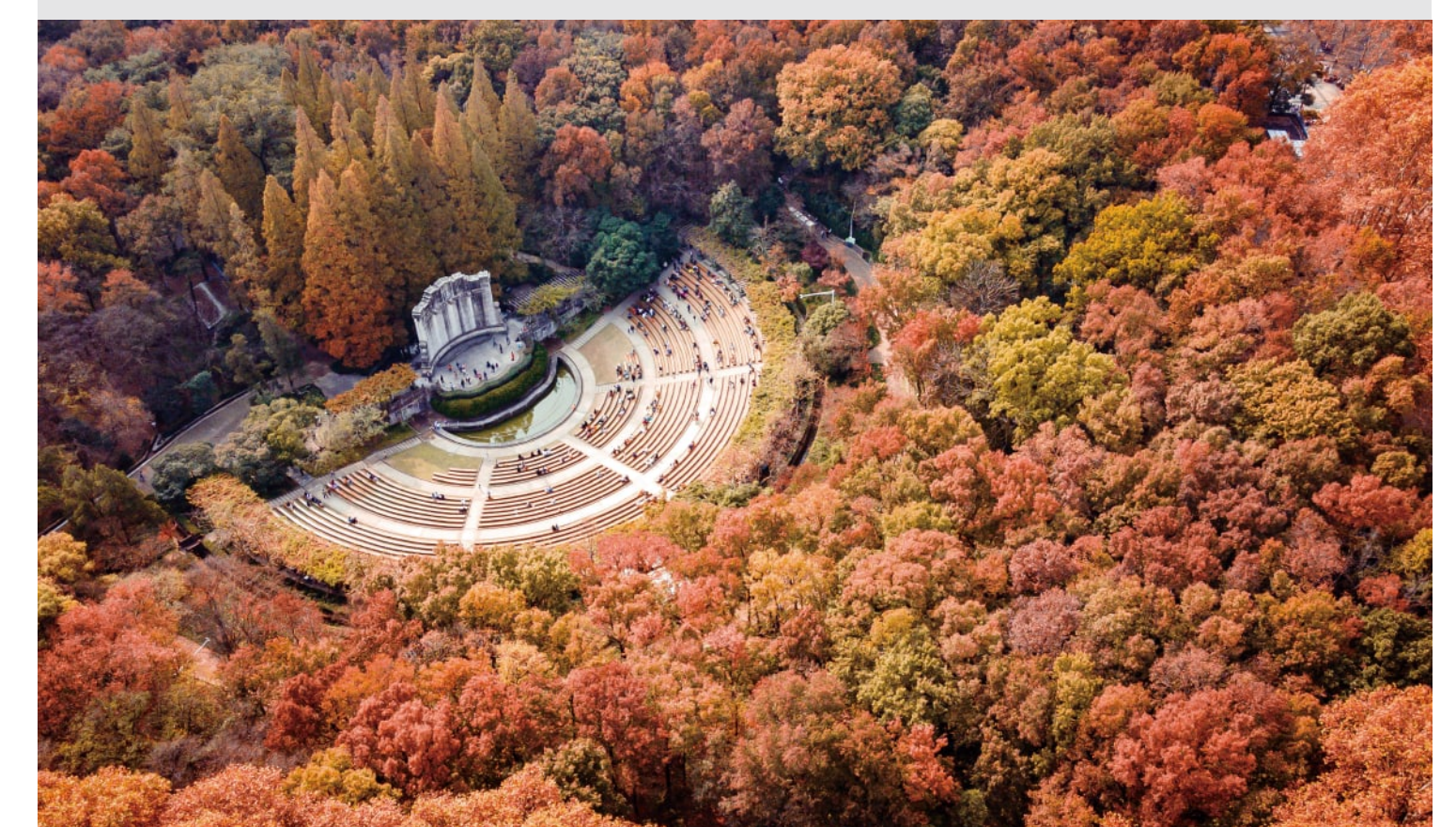

③ Sun Yat-sen Mausoleum 中山陵



The Sun Yat-sen Mausoleum is located in the Zhongshan Scenic Area in Nanjing, connected to the Linggu Temple in the east and the Ming Xiaoling Mausoleum in the west. The building complex is arranged along the central axis of the mountain in the shape of a "warning bell", including the Universal Love Pavilion, the Sacrifice Hall, etc. The 392 steps have a unique visual design. The Sacrifice Hall has a seated statue of Sun Yat-sen and is surrounded by buildings such as the music stand. The tomb chamber is not open to the public.

- 2. Take Nanjing Bus No. 34 or 201 to Sun Yat-sen Mausoleum Parking Lot Station, which is within walking distance.

④ Slender West Lake 瘦西湖



A must-see for a spring trip to Yangzhou is Slender West Lake, a garden nestled on a narrow river. Enjoy the scenery on foot or by boat. Entering from the South Gate, there are dozens of scenic spots along the lake.

The Five Pavilion Bridge and the Twenty-Four Bridges are iconic landmarks, rich with allusions to Emperor Qianlong. In summer, enjoy a night cruise to admire the lanterns and cool off.

⑤ Zhouzhuang Ancient Town 周庄古镇



Zhouzhuang is an ancient water town in the south of the Yangtze River. Its Ming and Qing Dynasty buildings are built along the river. There are scenic spots such as the Double Bridge and Zhangting. You can take a row-boat, watch the play "Only Zhouzhuang", relax and shop, stay in the ancient town and try delicacies such as Wansan Pig's Hoof. It is a perfect place for a relaxing trip.

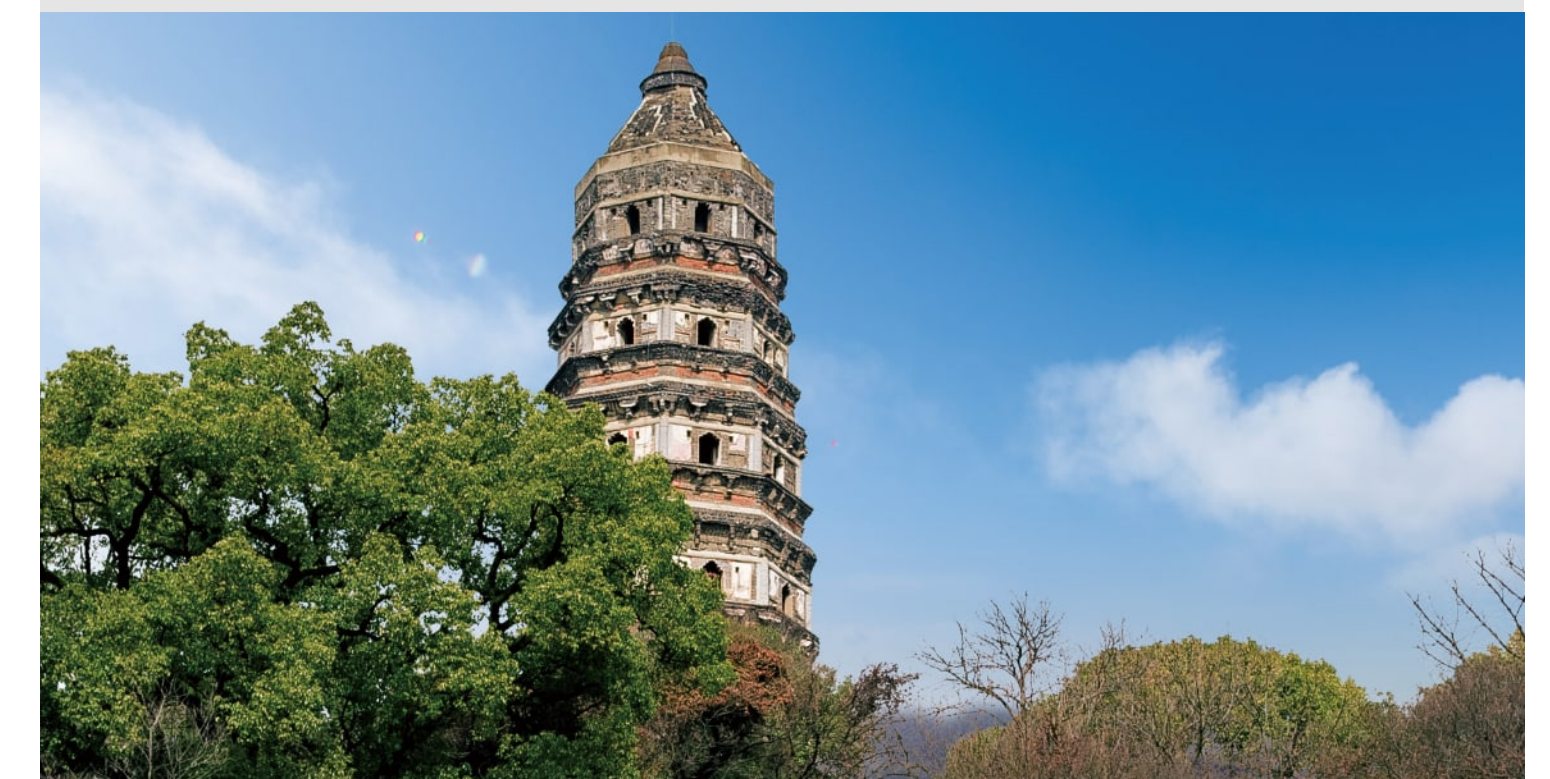

2. From the city center: Take Kunshan Bus No. 260 or 263 to the Zhouzhuang Health Center bus stop. Walk approximately 300 meters to the destination.

3. Vehicles, including bicycles, are not allowed in Zhouzhuang Ancient Town, except for small wooden boats in the river.

⑥ Tiger Hill 虎丘山



Tiger Hill Pagoda is located on Tiger Hill in Suzhou, 5 kilometers from the city center. Legend has it that it got its name from the White Tiger perched on the hill where King Helü of Wu was buried. Construction began in the Later Zhou Dynasty and was completed in the Northern Song Dynasty. The seven-story, eight-sided pagoda, though it has survived fire, now stands 47.5 meters tall. In 1956, treasures including Yue Kiln artifacts were discovered within the pagoda, which is also known as a leaning tower.

Located south of Qinlu Peak in Mashan, Wuxi, the Lingshan Giant Buddha, named after the Xiaoling Mountain, named after Xuanzang of the Tang Dynasty, is one of Wuxi's iconic landmarks. Facing Taihu Lake and backed by Lingshan Mountain, the statue's benevolent smile and broad gaze upon all beings is of great significance to the local social, cultural, and economic development. Two elevators within the podium take believers and tourists to the lotus seat for a "climbing Buddha's feet."

Yuantouzhu, located in Wuxi's Taihu Lake, is a peninsula in the northern part of the lake. Named for its resemblance to a floating turtle, it is surrounded by water on three sides and boasts gardens and the Taihu Fairy Island. Visitors can take a boat to the island or climb Luding Mountain for scenic views.

The area is also renowned for its Spring Cherry Blossom Festival, offering views from land, water, and air, as well as at night. The peak viewing period is usually mid-to-late March.

Mount Huaguo 花果山



Huaguo Mountain boasts a magnificent landscape of mountains and sea, boasting numerous lifelike attractions related to "Journey to the West," such as the Wa Stone and the Water Curtain Cave. The summit, Yunv Peak, is the highest peak in Jiangsu Province, and visitors can admire breathtaking views of the sea and the clouds.

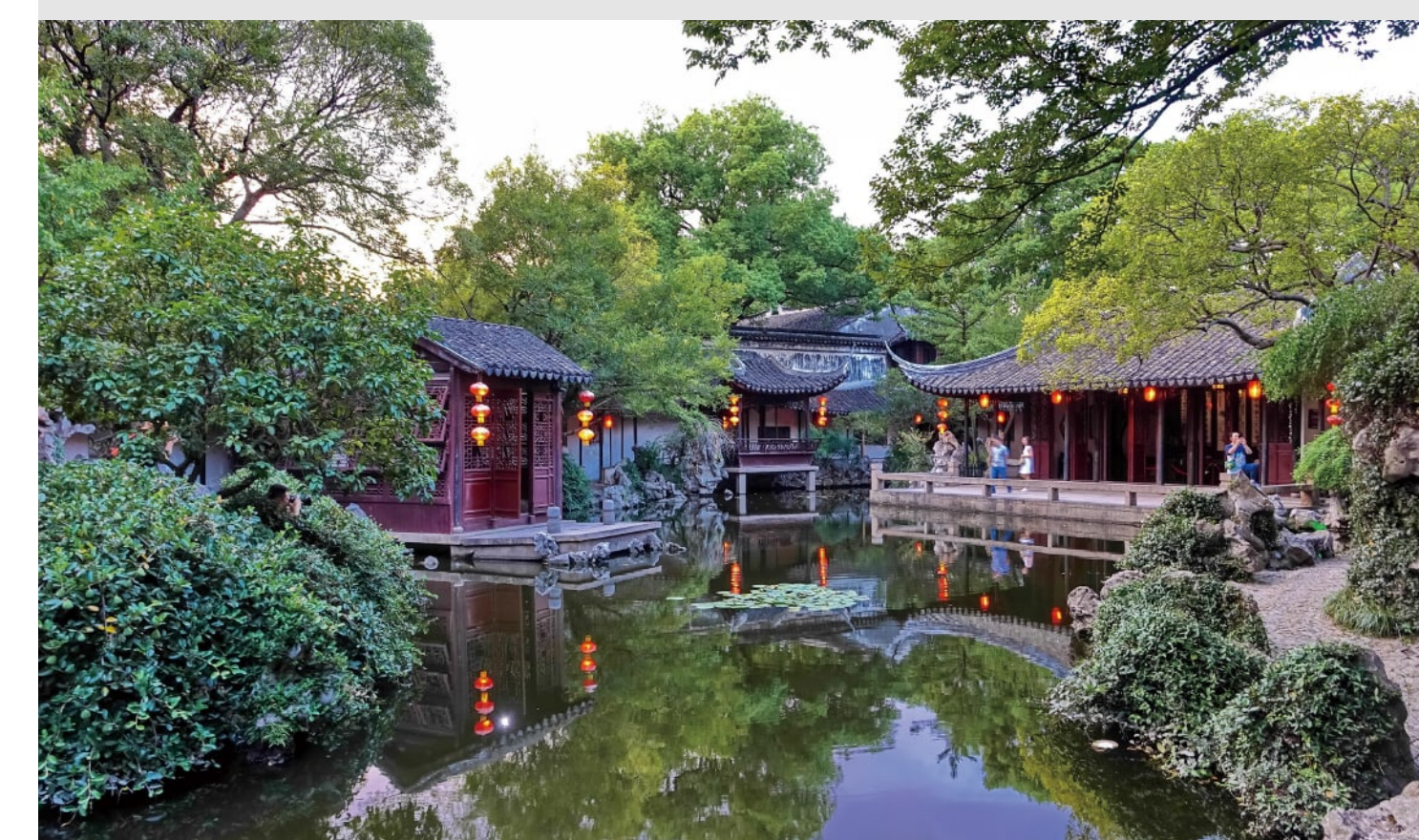

Tongli Ancient Town 同里古镇



Tongli Ancient Town, a Jiangnan water town located in Wujiang, Suzhou, is surrounded by lakes and divided into seven islands by rivers. Homes are nestled by the water, and the area is home to many old Ming and Qing dynasty buildings and narrow alleys. Quiet during the day, it shines brightly at night. Explore the area on foot or by paid pedicab, taking in sights like the Three Bridges and Luoxingzhou. Enjoy snacks like sock bottom pastries on Ming and Qing Street and Zhuxing Street. Enjoy tea and listen to pingtan (Chinese storytelling) at the Nanyuan Teahouse on the south side. Stay in the town's guesthouses or nearby hotels.

The China Dinosaur Park, with its biomimetic-looking China Dinosaur Hall as its hallmark, features multiple halls showcasing dinosaur culture and ecological conservation. The park offers a variety of exciting attractions and

leisure activities, including a water park in summer and nighttime access (separate ticket required for the water park).

Tianmu Lake 天目湖



Tianmu Lake, located on Yingbin Avenue in Liyang City, is small yet captivating for its stunning scenery. Spring is the perfect time to visit, when lush greenery surrounds the lake. Enjoy the fresh air, hot springs, and leisurely strolls, bike rides, and boat tours. You can also try a zipline between two islands for panoramic views. After your visit, try the delicious fish head soup and fish head pancakes.

Niu Shou Mountain Cultural Tourism Area 牛首山文化旅游区



The Niu Shou Mountain Cultural Tourism Area, named for its twin peaks resembling ox horns, boasts beautiful scenery and is known as the "Spring Niu Shou." It houses historical sites such as Yue Fei's former fortress where he fought against the Jin army. The central Buddha's Head Palace, housing the Buddha's skull relic, is a historic Buddhist sanctuary. The Peach Blossom Creek at the east entrance offers a captivating sea of flowers in spring.

It offers a variety of recreational opportunities, as well as opportunities for scientific education and revolutionary education.

16 Huishan Ancient Town 惠山古镇



Huishan Ancient Town, located in Wuxi, Jiangsu Province, is known as the "Open-Air Museum of Wuxi's History and Culture." Centered around the Huishan Ancestral Halls, it boasts a vibrant collection of Ming and Qing dynasty architecture, scenic gardens, and the former residences of prominent figures, including Jichang Garden, Huishan Temple, and the Second Spring Under Heaven. The ancient town blends natural beauty with cultural heritage, showcasing the elegance of Jiangnan water towns and the profoundness of Wu culture. With a clear historical context and rich ancient charm, it epitomizes Jiangnan regional culture.

Eating

Jiangsu cuisine, one of China's four major culinary styles, draws on the distinctive flavors of Huaiyang, Jinling, Suxi, and Xuhai, emphasizing exquisite knife skills and meticulous cooking techniques.

Yangzhou's braised crab meat and lion's head are tender and fragrant, while Wensi's tofu is as fine as hair; Suzhou's squirrel-crusted mandarin fish is crispy on the outside and tender on the inside, while Biluo shrimp with tea aroma is refreshing; Wuxi's braised spare ribs are sweet and smooth without being greasy, while Nanjing's salted duck is savory and flavorful. Xuhai's Farewell My Concubine soup is rich and nourishing, while street-style crab roe soup dumplings are juicy and filling.

Seasonal delicacies intertwine with local flavors, each flavor imbuing the freshness and sweetness of Jiangnan and the essence of "never tired of fine food."

◆ Nanjing salted duck 南京盐水鸭

Nanjing salted duck is the soul of Jinling cuisine, earning the reputation of "Jinling duck is the best in the world" and a seasonal delicacy on Nanjing's tables. Selected fresh, tender duck skin is marinated with salt, ginger, scallions, and other spices, then slow-cooked at low temperatures to lock in its flavor. The resulting dish boasts a white, smooth, jade-like skin and tender, firm meat, offering a refreshingly salty, fragrant, and sweet aftertaste without any greasiness. Unlike roast duck, which is often overcooked with rich sauces, this dish embodies the gentle elegance of Jiangnan cuisine with its authentic flavors.



◆ Yangzhou fried rice 扬州炒饭

Yangzhou fried rice is a classic Huaiyang cuisine dish. It uses carefully selected indica rice as its base, along with eggs, ham, shrimp, and bamboo shoots, all stir-fried in lard over high heat, resulting in each grain being distinct and glistening. It has the perfect balance of saltiness and freshness, with a rich egg aroma that blends seamlessly with the natural flavors of the ingredients, leaving it soft and smooth without being greasy. This dish, which has evolved from Yangzhou banquets to the everyday dining table, embodies the Huaiyang cuisine's ingenuity, known for its exquisite craftsmanship, while also conveying the warmth of a homely home.



◆ Suzhou squirrel fish 苏州松鼠桂鱼

Suzhou Squirrel Mandarin Fish is a classic Suzhou dish. Made with mandarin fish, it's carved and deep-fried to resemble a squirrel. Doused in a sweet and sour marinade, it's crispy on the outside and tender on the inside, perfectly balanced between sweet and sour.



◆ Wuxi braised pork ribs 无锡酱排骨

Known as "Wuxi's No. 1 Dish," this dish features carefully selected, tender pork ribs, simmered for hours in a secret sauce of soy sauce, rock sugar, and other ingredients, resulting in an alluring, bright red color. The meat is tender and fall-off-the-bone, with a rich, savory blend of sweet and salty, showcasing the rich, savory flavors of Jiangnan.



◆ Yangcheng Lake hairy crab 阳澄湖大闸蟹

Yangcheng Lake hairy crabs have green backs, white bellies, golden claws, and yellow hair. Their roe is like gold, their paste is like jade, and their meat is sweet and tender. Steamed in autumn, they fill the room with fragrance and are a natural delicacy from the Jiangnan water towns.



◆ Zhenjiang pot-covered noodles 镇江锅盖面

镇江锅盖面

Zhenjiang Pot Cover Noodles, known as Jiangnan's "No. 1 Noodle," boasts a tradition spanning over 300 years. Made using the "jumping noodle" technique, the noodles are chewy and smooth. Cooked in a large pot with a small lid, the broth boils without overflowing, ensuring even cooking. The red broth, made with bone broth and fish broth and Hengshun soy sauce, is rich and savory, and can be enjoyed with a variety of toppings, including braised pork and long fish. As one of the "Three Wonders of Zhenjiang," it was listed as a provincial intangible cultural heritage in 2009.



◆ Xuzhou clay pot chicken 徐州地锅鸡

Originating in Xuzhou, Jiangsu Province, clay pot chicken is a classic representative of northern Jiangsu cuisine. It's made with free-range chicken and flour flatbread, slow-cooked in an iron pot. Cooking over a wood-fired stove imparts a unique smoky aroma, resulting in tender and juicy chicken, while the flatbread soaks up the rich broth, leaving it crispy on the outside and soft on the inside. The broth is spicy but not overpowering, and overflowing with fragrance. A staple dish at farmhouse banquets, it embodies the memories of home and the warmth of family reunion, making it an ideal choice for warming up in winter or gatherings with friends and family.
