
Transportation

- Subway: Take Line 1 to Longxiang Bridge Station. Walk about 400 meters to West Lake.
- Bus: Take Bus K4 or Bus No. 2 to Su Causeway Station, Bus No. 28 or Bus No. 15 to Yuquan Station, or Bus No. 27 or Bus No. 7 to Yuefen Station. All are within walking distance.

Travel Season

March to May is the best time to stroll along the Su Causeway and enjoy the flowers. From September to November, the weather is crisp and clear, and the sweet fragrance of osmanthus flowers fills the air for miles. However, midsummer is not recommended, as the scorching temperatures exceeding 30°C will dampen your interest.

② Lingyin Feilai Peak Scenic Area 灵隐飞来峰景区

Putuoshan Scenic Area 普陀山风景区



Putuoshan Island, accessible by boat, is a long, narrow island with three main areas of scenic beauty, requiring 2-3 days to explore. Its core area is religious, with renowned temples such as Puji Temple and the Nanhai Guanyin statue. There are also beaches. Prices on the island are high, so it's recommended to bring your own snacks; you can sample the temple's vegetarian dishes. Accommodation must be booked in advance.

- Buses: Putuoshan has two dedicated tourist bus lines connecting most scenic spots.
- ① Line 1: Baibusa (Puji Temple), Baibuge, Zizhulin, Rusanmadhi, Pier, Haifang New Village, Seafood Garden, Baotuo Hotel, Xitian Ferry (not available during incense festivals and special holidays).
- 2 Line 2: Baibusa (Puji Temple), Chaoyang Cave, Dacheng Temple, Fayu Temple, Feisha'ao, Baoyue Temple, Ancient Buddha Cave, Cable Car Station.
- Taxi: Putuoshan's scenic spots are scattered, so group charters are more cost-effective. A 12-seat domestically produced Toyota van costs 400-600 yuan/day, while a 20-seat domestically produced Toyota minibus costs 800-1000 yuan/day. Putuoshan has distinct off-seasons and peak seasons, so prices are negotiable during off-seasons.

⑤ Shenxianju Scenic Area 神仙居景区



Located in Baita Town, Xianju County, Shenxianju combines the secluded beauty of Tiantai Mountain with the dramatic beauty of Yandang Mountain. Its volcanic rhyolite formations dominate, with over a hundred scenic spots divided into four major gates. Tours can be made by cable car or on foot, taking 3-4 hours. The best time to visit is from June to August and in winter.



• Transportation within the scenic area:
There is a shuttle bus at the entrance of the scenic area visitor center. There are two round-trip shuttle buses from the visitor center to the south gate and the visitor center to the north gate. There is no shuttle bus between the north and south gates.

Tips

- ① From the North Gate, get off at the South Gate. Bus No. 1 takes you back to the North Gate for free, and the journey takes about 20 minutes.
- 2 The starting fare for a taxi in Xianju is 5 yuan.
- ③ Prices are high on the mountain, so bring your own food and water.



Tiantai Mountain Scenic Area, a national key scenic spot located 2 kilometers from Tiantai County, is characterized by its unique rock formations, dramatic peaks, and picturesque valleys. Three cascading lakes, each with its own unique charm, and clusters of waterfalls converge, showcasing the essence of the mountains and waters, creating a vibrant and captivating scene of "clear lakes, secluded pools, cascading waterfalls, and flowing springs."

• From Jiaojiang, Huangyan, and Luqiao in Taizhou City, you can take local buses to Tiantai County at Taizhou Passenger Transport Terminal, West Passenger Transport Terminal, and South Passenger Transport Terminal respectively. There is a bus every half an hour or so, and the transportation is very convenient. After arriving at Tiantai County Station, you can take buses from Tiantai Station to Tiantai Mountain and various tourist attractions, and you can basically go as you please.

Tips

There are buses of all sizes that connect to all major scenic areas of Tiantai Mountain, so you don't have to go back and forth. The entrance fee to Tiantai Mountain is 10 yuan, and you can walk around the scenic area.

Wuzhen Scenic Area乌镇景区



Wuzhen, an ancient Jiangnan town in Tongxiang, is divided into two major scenic areas: East and West. It served as the filming location for the film "A Time to Live." East is a vibrant area with folk performances and historical sites, while West is ideal for nighttime strolls, dining, and boat rides. A one- to two-day visit is recommended, with delicacies like braised lamb and local specialties like blue printed cloth worth experiencing.



- ① Wuzhen doesn't have an airport. If you're flying, you can fly to nearby cities like Shanghai and Hangzhou, then transfer to a train or long-distance bus.
- 2 Take a train to Tongxiang Railway Station, then take bus K282 to Wuzhen Bus Station.
- ③ Take a long-distance bus directly to Tongxiang Bus Station and transfer to Wuzhen Bus Station. Direct buses run from Shanghai, Hangzhou, Xitang, and other cities to Wuzhen Bus Station. After arriving at Wuzhen Bus Station by any of these methods, take bus K350 to Wuzhen's East and West Scenic Areas. There are free shuttle buses between the East and West Scenic Areas, or you can walk.

Enjoying a vibrant atmosphere of local life, visitors can savor tea and music, take a night boat ride, stroll through its corridors, and gaze at the scenery, all while savoring the charm of a slow-paced life.

- Rail: Xitang is centrally located between Shanghai, Hangzhou, and Suzhou, offering frequent train services to these three cities from all over China. The Shanghai-Hangzhou Railway passes through Jiaxing and Jiashan Stations, both of which offer direct bus services to Xitang.
- Air: Xitang is within a two-hour drive of Shanghai Pudong International Airport, Hang-zhou Xiaoshan International Airport, and Shanghai Hongqiao Airport, all accessible via highways.
- Xitang Tourist Bus Lines: To facilitate travel, direct tourist buses have been launched at the Hangzhou, Shaoxing, Ningbo, and Suzhou Passenger Transport Centers. Major hotels in Shanghai, Zhejiang, and Jiangsu have also established Xitang tour routes.

Hengdian World Studios 横店影视城



Known as "Jiangnan's First Town" and "Oriental Hollywood," Hengdian, located along the prime tourist route of central Zhejiang, is the world's largest film and television production center. It boasts eight scenic areas, including the Qin Palace, and China's largest and most comprehensive indoor filming facility, covering over 8,000 square meters. We recommend a full day or more of exploring the area, with an overnight stay to fully experience its charm.

♥ Shuanglong Scenic Tourist Area 双龙风景旅游区



The Shuanglong Scenic Area, covering 7.95 square kilometers, boasts a diverse array of natural landscapes, including karst landscapes, cultural and historical attractions, and outdoor recreational spots. It boasts distinctive caves like Shuanglong Cave, cultural attractions like Zhizhe Temple and Wong Tai Sin Temple, and recreational areas like the Xiake Ancient Trail and Lu Nu Lake.

Nianbadu, a nationally recognized historical and cultural town, boasts a history spanning over a thousand years. Its unique geographical location once housed a guerrilla government office. It boasts 36 preserved historical buildings and 11 public structures, each showcasing a diverse range of styles. With a population of over 3,600, the town boasts 13 dialects and 142 surnames, and boasts a rich tradition of folk art, earning it the nickname "Natural Folk Museum."

Xiandu Scenic Area boasts a diverse range of mountainous beauty and dramatic beauty.

Dinghu Peak is known as the "Number One Peak in the World."

Legend has it that Huangdi refined elixir here, and the Huangdi Temple is located here, forming a "northern mausoleum and southern shrine" structure. The area encompasses four scenic areas and over 300 attractions, creating a "natural photography studio." In March, the rapeseed blossoms are in full bloom, creating a captivating spectacle.

Yunhe Rice Terraces is one of the largest rice terraces scenic areas in East China, known for its terraced fields, sea of clouds, and sunrises. The waterscapes in May and June, the yellow rice paddies in October, and the snow in winter are all captivating. The area is divided into two sections: Silver Valley and Nine-Bend Cloud Ring. Silver Valley is more popular, and it's recommended to stay overnight to watch the sunrise and stargazing. You can also visit Kenggen Stone Village.



• Driving routes to the Yunhe Terraces cover four main routes: Hangzhou, Taizhou, Wenzhou, and Jinhua. Three routes are available in Hangzhou, starting via different sections, such as Times Avenue and the Airport Expressway; two routes in Taizhou, using either the Taijin Expressway or the Shenhai Expressway; one route in Wenzhou, starting from Lucheng Road; and two routes in Jinhua, using either the Changshen Expressway or the Shanghai-Kunming Expressway. All routes ultimately connect to the Changshen Expressway, exiting at Yunhe West, and then reach the scenic area via Provincial Highway 53 and the Houchong section.

♥ Tianyi Pavilion • Moon LakeScenic Area 天一阁•月湖景区



The Tianyi Pavilion Museum, located on the west bank of Yuehu Lake in Ningbo, is centered around the Tianyi Pavilion, my country's oldest surviving private library. Built by Fan Qin, a retired official during the Jiajing period of the Ming Dynasty, the pavilion houses ancient books and desks, evoking a rich literary atmosphere.

The museum embodies the architectural style of a Jiangnan garden, with its East and South Gardens boasting rockery, ponds, and tranquil surroundings. The park also houses the Mingzhou Stele Forest, a calligraphy and painting gallery, Dongming Thatched Cottage, the Qin Clan Ancestral Hall, the Fan

Clan's former residence, and a Mahjong Exhibition Hall showcasing the origins and development of mahjong culture.

Zhejiang cuisine is a gustatory poem flowing through the landscapes of Wu and Yue. Inheriting two thousand years of cultural heritage, it draws upon the four major schools of Hangzhou, Ningbo, Shaoxing, and Wenzhou, blending the philosophy of "eating in season" with meticulous craftsmanship.

At banquets, Longjing shrimp imbued with the fragrance of tea, rock sugar soft-shelled turtle gleams with an amber luster, and Songsao fish soup evokes the elegant charm of the Southern Song Dynasty. In the marketplace, Jinhua pastries are flaky and crispy, Ningbo tangyuan are soft and glutinous, and Quzhou's three-headed and one-palm stews are rich and fragrant. From the red-roe crabs of the East China Sea to the braised meats of dried vegetables in the mountains, from the intangible cultural heritage tea cakes to the street-side youzanzi, each flavor holds the secret of local culture within its salty, fresh, and sweet flavors.

◆ West Lake Vinegar Fish 西湖醋鱼

West Lake Vinegar Fish is a Hangzhou specialty and the soul of Zhejiang cuisine, known as the "First Flavor of West Lake." The ingredients are meticulously selected, using only fresh grass carp, starved to remove the earthy smell, then killed and cooked immediately. The dish is meticulously prepared, first blanching in boiling water to set the fish's shape. The fish is white, tender, and shaped like garlic cloves. The key lies in the secret sweet and sour marinade, a blend of sugar, vinegar, and soy sauce that creates a balanced sweet and sour balance, rich but not greasy. Drizzled over the fish, it radiates a bright amber red.



◆ Dongpo Pork 东坡肉

Dongpo Pork is a classic Zhejiang cuisine dish, made with slow-cooked pork belly, resulting in a bright red and juicy texture. It's rich yet tender, tender and glutinous, with a mellow blend of salty and sweet, revealing the rich flavors of the Jiangnan region.



◆ Ningbo Glutinous Rice Balls 宁波汤圆

Ningbo glutinous rice balls are a representative of Zhejiang-style desserts. They are made of snow-white glutinous rice wrapped in lard and black sesame filling. After cooking, they are soft, chewy and chewy. When you bite into them, the sweet and fragrant filling opens up, showing the sweet and mellow taste of Jiangnan.



◆ Stir-fried Crab with Red Roe 红膏炝蟹

Stir-fried red crab roe is the soul of Ningbo cuisine. Made with East China Sea swimming crabs, the roe is rich and quickly marinated. The crab roe is a vibrant red, while the meat is a translucent white like jelly. The salty, fresh, and tender crab meat is a true treasure of the sea.



◆ Shaoxing Stinky Tofu 绍兴臭豆腐

Shaoxing stinky tofu is a Zhejiang specialty, fermented using traditional techniques. Crispy on the outside and tender on the inside, it has a slightly pungent aroma and a rich, salty, and mellow taste. Dipping it in chili sauce further enhances its flavor, imbuing it with the flavor of Jiangnan street life.



◆ Braised Pork with Preserved Vegetables 梅干菜扣肉

Braised pork belly with preserved mustard greens is a classic Zhejiang cuisine. The pork belly is fatty but not greasy, and the preserved mustard greens absorb the meat's flavor. The savory and savory blend creates a crispy, tender, and flavorful dish, showcasing the rich, homely flavors of Jiangnan cuisine.



◆ Wenzhou Fish Balls 温州鱼丸

Wenzhou fish balls are a representative of Wenzhou's intangible cultural heritage. Hand-pounded and kneaded from carefully selected fresh East China Sea fish, each ball is plump and smooth. The clear, fresh broth and chewy, tender and tender texture perfectly capture the authentic fishery flavors of the southern Zhejiang coast.



◆ Wenzhou Duck Tongue 温州鸭舌

This is a famous delicacy from southern Zhejiang, made from carefully selected fresh and tender duck tongues. It has a bright red color, a rich marinated aroma, and a springy, savory, and mellow taste, fully showcasing the essence of Wenzhou marinated food.



◆ Jinhua Ham 金华火腿

Jinhua ham is the heart of Zhejiang cuisine, ranked among the "three most famous hams in the world." Made from premium pork hind legs, it undergoes 48 traditional fermentation steps. Its vibrant crimson color, rich and savory, is a timeless delicacy of Jiangnan cuisine.




◆ Jiaxing Zongzi 嘉兴粽子

Jiaxing Zongzi is a leader in the Jiangnan region, renowned for its glutinous yet glutinous texture, fragrant and delicious flavor. The fresh meat Zongzi is juicy and fragrant, while the red bean paste Zongzi is sweet and dense, showcasing the exquisite flavors of Jiangnan dim sum.



◆ Quzhou Three-Headed Palm 衢州三头一掌

Quzhou's "Three Heads and One Palm" is a signature delicacy of western Zhejiang cuisine, consisting of duck head, rabbit head, fish head, and duck feet. The secret broth is simmered with dozens of spices, and the ingredients are braised for a long time, fully absorbing the rich aroma of the brine and resulting in an alluring bright red color. It's salty at first, then spicy, with a hint of spiciness. The duck head is firm and springy, the rabbit head is tender and flavorful, the fish head is plump and tender, and the duck feet are rich and gelatinous. The more you chew, the more delicious it becomes. This truly embodies the hearty culinary style of Quzhou and is a classic delicacy for both late-night snacks and dinner tables.
