Within its 60 square kilometers, the 9-kilometer-long Jiuxi River flows alongside 36 peaks, creating a picturesque landscape of emerald waters and crimson cliffs. As a famous mountain for the three religions (Confucianism, Taoism, and Buddhism), it has accessible entrances from both the north and south. Scenic spots such as Tianyou Peak and Dahongpao Mountain are scattered throughout the area, and visitors can explore them by sightseeing bus or on foot.



Yongding Tulou永定土楼



The Yongding Tulou Cluster, a World Cultural Heritage site and a 5A scenic area, boasts exquisite tulou buildings such as Zhenchenglou and Chengqilou. The round and square tulou buildings are interspersed, showcasing

the wisdom of the Hakka people through a blend of Chinese and Western styles. Visitors can also enjoy unique experiences such as Shifan music and Hakka wedding ceremonies. Stroll through the ancient village, touch the rammed earth texture, and feel the rich and vibrant culture of centuries-old settlements.

- Independent travel: Most areas are not accessible by public transportation, such as

the Gaobei Tulou Cluster, Hongkeng Tulou Cluster, and Chuxi Tulou Cluster in Yongding. It is recommended to book a local day tour to save time and hassle, avoiding the hassle of transferring.

Tips

There are thousands of Hakka Tulou (earthen buildings), with Zhencheng Building and Chengqi Building being must-see highlights.

The best time to visit is around the time of the Grain in Ear solar term or during the Spring Festival, when you can enjoy the terraced fields shrouded in mist and folk activities. For individual travelers, meals are affordable; when purchasing dried goods, prioritize dark-colored dried bamboo shoots and loose dried vegetables.

Qingyuan Mountain 清源山

Developed since the Qin Dynasty, it is dotted with relics from Confucianism, Buddhism, and Taoism, including Laozi Rock, the stupa containing the relics of Master Hongyi, and cliff carvings from various dynasties, all rich in cultural heritage. Visitors can enjoy tea tasting, sample local farm-style cuisine at the summit, and overlook the

ancient city of Quanzhou – a truly enjoyable experience.

 The highest elevation of the main scenic area is 498 meters. The climate is warm and humid, with mild winters and cool summers, and a long frost-free period throughout the year, making it suitable for sightseeing in all seasons.



Pingtan Island, shrouded in mist from the east, is the fifth largest island in Fujian Province, boasting over 400 kilometers of coast-line with fine white sand beaches and crystal-clear waters. 



The fortress houses the world's most valuable Krupp cannon and its iron molds, and boasts stunning coastal views and a wealth of activities, making it a culturally rich and diverse cultural tourism and leisure destination along the Island Ring Road.

Eating

Fujian cuisine embodies the bounty of mountains and seas and the charm of a thousand years, with each city offering its own unique flavor. Buddha Jumps Over the Wall is simmered to perfection, while Satay Noodles blend East and West, and Meat Swallow and Flatbread showcase the craftsmanship of its artisans. Other delicacies include Sea Worm Jelly, Ginger Duck, and Bamboo Shoot Cake, all offering a balanced blend of sweetness and savory flavors, and incorporating medicinal and culinary traditions—each bite a vibrant expression of Fujian's culinary culture.

◆ Oyster Omelet 海蛎煎

Freshly caught oysters are coated in sweet potato starch and fried in a pan, sizzling as they dance with beaten egg. Garlic chili sauce and scallions are sprinkled on top. Crispy on the outside and tender on the inside, the oysters are springy and sweet, while the sweet potato starch is soft and chewy. Each bite is bursting with the flavor of southern Fujian's local cuisine and authentic freshness.



◆ Shacha Noodles 沙茶面

The soup is rich and mellow, with the dry fragrance of peanut butter and fish and shrimp. The alkaline round noodles are chewy and tasty. You can add various seafood, vegetarian, pork offal, stewed and other ingredients according to your personal preferences.



◆ Ginger Duck 姜母鸭

We choose low-fat Muscovy ducks that are over 100 days old, add more than 20 kinds of medicinal herbs and spices, drizzle with rice wine and sesame oil, and slow-cook in an old casserole. The duck meat and bones are tender and tasty, and even the ginger is delicious. It is a warm but not dry medicinal delicacy.



◆ Groundnut Jelly 土笋冻

Use star worms from the sea to cook soup, only add salt for seasoning, and form jelly after cooling. The taste is a mixture of seafood and bamboo shoots. It can be eaten with garlic soy sauce, coriander and pickled radish slices.



◆ Fish Ball Soup 鱼丸汤

Most of Xiamen fish balls are stuffed with shark paste on the outside and seasoned pork puree on the inside. When you bite them, the gravy will pop out. There are also many flavors such as shrimp, crab roe, cuttlefish, etc.



◆ Dumplings 扁食

The filling of Xiamen flatbread is very particular. The selected pork hind leg meat is pounded into a fine meat paste. Each piece is firm, plump and fragrant. Flatbread is divided into two types: ordinary flatbread with paper-thin skin, wrapped with meat filling and dancing lightly in boiling water; flatbread with bird's nest skin is more ingenious, with pork paste mixed with cassava flour repeatedly rolled into a transparent thin skin, which is chewy and smooth. The moment you bite it, the meat fragrance and the soft dough skin bloom on your tongue layer by layer. It can be called a smart and wonderful snack in southern Fujian.



◆ Peanut Soup 花生汤

Peanuts need to be peeled, dried in the sun, and soaked for a long time, and then cooked to just the right temperature. The peanuts will be soft but not mushy, and have a refreshing and mellow flavor. Eggs can be added to enhance the flavor.
