Yellow Crane Tower黄鹤楼



The Yellow Crane Tower is located on Snake Hill on the south bank of the Yangtze River in Wuhan. Originally built in the second year of the Huangwu era of the Wu Kingdom during the Three Kingdoms period, it was rebuilt in 1985. A national 5A scenic area and one of the three famous towers south of the Yangtze River, it is renowned worldwide for the poems written by poets such as Cui Hao. Climbing the tower offers panoramic views of the Yangtze River and the three towns of Wuhan.



② Donghu Ecological Tourism Scenic Area 东湖生态旅游风景区



East Lake Scenic Area is a national 5A-level scenic area in Wuhan, comprising four distinctive scenic areas: Tingtao, Moshan, Luoyan, and Chuidi. A 101.98-kilometer greenway connects the entire area with attractions such as the Hubei Provincial Museum and Happy Valley. Here, visitors can enjoy cherry blossoms, bird watching, mountain climbing, and leisure activities. The Hubei Provincial Museum houses four national treasures, making it a comprehensive tourist destination that combines nature and culture.



Huangpi Mulan Cultural and Ecological
 Tourism Area 黄陂木兰文化生态旅游区



Located approximately 30 kilometers from the city center, the area comprises four scenic spots, including Mulan Grassland and Mulan Mountain, each requiring half a day to a full day to explore. A tour bus connects the four sites, offering opportunities for mountain climbing for summer retreat, water activities and accommodation, grassland exploration, and, in spring, the Yunwu Mountain bursting with blooming rhododendrons.

4 Ancient Longzhong古隆中



Located 15 kilometers from the city center, a 40-minute drive, the ancient Longzhong in Xiangyang is said to be the place where Zhuge Liang lived in seclusion and farmed, and the stories of "Three Visits to the

Thatched Cottage" and "Longzhong Dialogue" took place here. The scenic area is small and can be explored on foot. It features reconstructed landscapes such as the stone archway, the fields where Zhuge Liang farmed, the thatched cottage, and the Wuhou Temple. Climbing the Tengwang Pavilion offers views of the pastoral scenery.

© Qu Yuan's Hometown 屈原故里



The Qu Yuan Hometown Cultural Tourism Area is located in Zigui County, Yichang, the hometown of the poet Qu Yuan. The core attraction is the Qu Yuan Temple, which has been relocated twice. Other attractions include the Dragon Boat Museum, the Dragon Boat Festival Customs Museum, and replicas of incense burner terraces and other relics related to Qu Yuan's life. Visitors can also enjoy the scenery of the high gorges and calm lakes.

♦ Three Gorges Family 三峡人家



The Three Gorges Family Scenic Area is located in the Xiling Gorge of Yichang. It consists of houses built on mountains, waterways, and along streams. Visitors need to take a ferry from the north bank (the entrance ticket includes round-trip ferry tickets) to the south

bank for a tour. The scenic area is lush with greenery and babbling brooks. Visitors can admire stilted houses, the "Lantern Shadow Stone," and watch folk performances of Ba-Chu customs such as boatmen's chants and boatmen pulling tow ropes, immersing themselves in the original ecological scenery and culture of the Three Gorges.

• The Three Gorges Family Scenic Area offers various transportation options:

From the airport, train station, or long-distance bus station, you can first go to Yiling Square and then transfer to bus route 10-1 (first bus at 7:05, fare 15 yuan) to reach the scenic area.

We recommend the Gezhouba No. 3 Ship Lock Wharf special cruise ship (departing at 8:30/10:30, including entrance fee, return at 18:00), which offers views of the Xiling Gorge. If driving, exit the highway at the Yemingzhu exit and follow the signs; the scenic area is about an hour away. Tickets for the scenic area must be purchased at the Hujintan Visitor Center on the north bank. The cable car costs 30 yuan one way; the ferry fee is included in the entrance fee.

Travel Season

Spring and autumn are for enjoying the autumn foliage, summer is for escaping the heat, but winter is too cold for cruise ships as they are closed.

② Changyang Qingjiang Gallery 长阳清江画廊



The Qingjiang River is the birthplace of the Ba people and the mother river of the Tujia people, hence the name Qingjiang Gallery. The scenic area offers two cruise routes: Route A includes attractions such as the Qingjiang Buddha and Wuluo Zhongli Mountain, taking 4-5 hours round trip; Route B does not include Wuluo Zhongli Mountain, taking 2 hours round trip and offering views of canyons and karst landforms.



Three Gorges Waterfall三峡大瀑布



The Three Gorges Waterfall is a national 5A scenic area in Yichang, less than 20 kilometers from the city center, and is one of China's top ten famous waterfalls. The scenic area stretches for 5 kilometers, featuring dense forests and beautiful waterfalls, including

dozens of attractions such as the Ginkgo Tree Waterfall, and allows visitors to "walk through" the waterfalls at close range. The newly added Yeren Valley scenic area boasts a four-tiered waterfall with a 200-meter drop, making it a perfect place to escape the summer heat and enjoy pristine natural scenery.

- By public transport: Take bus route 100 or 101 to the Xiaoxita terminal station, then transfer to a bus heading towards Xiaofeng.
 The route first stops at Qingrenquan Scenic Area, then proceeds to the Three Gorges Waterfall Scenic Area.
- Sightseeing bus fares: Three Gorges Waterfall 20 yuan/person, Jinshi Cave 10 yuan/person.

Wudang Mountain武当山



Wudang Mountain, located in Danjiangkou City, Shiyan, is a sacred site of Taoism and the birthplace of Wudang martial arts. The magnificent and mysterious ancient architectural complex, built during the Yongle era, includes scenic areas such as Taizipo, Zixiao Palace, and the Golden Summit, which can be explored by sightseeing bus. Combining natural and cultural beauty, it's ideal for a two-day trip. Autumn is the best season for viewing the red leaves, attracting martial arts enthusiasts to seek out masters and learn their skills.



Chibi Ancient Battlefield 赤壁古战场



The ancient battlefield of Chibi is located in Chibi Town, Chibi City. It is the only ancient battlefield from the Battle of Chibi that still retains its original appearance. After the battle, the Three Kingdoms period came to an end. The scenic area mainly consists of man-made attractions, including the Chibi cliff carvings and the Zhou Yu stone statue. It can be explored on foot, and the stone carvings are the iconic landscape.

Shennong Stream神农溪纤



Shennong Stream, originally named Yandu River, is said to have been named after Shennong Yandi. It is divided into three gorges: Longchang, Yingwu, and Shennong, as well as the Mianzhu Gorge tributary. The round trip by boat takes about 4 hours, during which tourists can enjoy the scenery of steep cliffs and green mountains, monkeys and deer, and

mysterious hanging coffins. They can then transfer to "pea pod" wooden boats and watch Tujia folk song performances and boatmen pulling boats.



Enshi Grand Canyon恩施大峡谷



Enshi Grand Canyon is a national 5A-level geological park, a "natural museum" of complex karst landforms. It features the "beautiful scar of the earth," Yunlong Ground Fissure, the iconic "One Incense Stick" landscape, as well as cliffside walkways, the thousand-year-old welcoming pine tree, and other attractions, boasting pristine and magnificent natural scenery.

- ① From Enshi City, take Aviation Avenue, then Tusi Road and Qifeng Avenue onto National Highway 318. After a few minutes, take the right-hand fork into the road leading to the Grand Canyon Scenic Area. The Grand Canyon parking lot (Ma'anlong Parking Lot) will be reached in a little over an hour.
- ② From Enshi, take National Highway 318 directly. After reaching Tuanbao Town, exit the highway on the right onto the Grand Canyon dedicated road to reach the Ma'anlong Parking Lot.

Shennongjia 神农架



Tenglong Cave Scenic Area is located 8 kilometers outside Lichuan City. It is a giant karst cave, more than 50 kilometers long, with about 6 kilometers open to tourists. It can be reached by a special bus from the train station. The scenic area consists of a front cave and a back cave. The front cave contains mountains and attractions such as the Colorful Gorge. Visitors can also enjoy laser shows and Tujia folk song and dance dramas.

Shennongjia Scenic Area, named after Shennong, the legendary Chinese herbalist, is located at the eastern end of the Qinling-Bashan Mountains. It is a World Natural Heritage site and a national 5A-level

scenic area. With its well-preserved ecology, diverse geological features, and natural mysteries such as the "Yeren" (wild man), it comprises seven major scenic areas and is a sacred place integrating sightseeing, scientific research, and leisure.

The cuisine of Hubei province embodies the abundance and vibrant life of this land of fish and rice, characterized by its "fresh, fragrant, and slightly spicy" flavors and its expertise in steaming and stewing. The aroma of hot dry noodles awakens the city in the early morning, while the slow-cooked pork rib and lotus root soup warms the heart with a touch of nostalgia. Steamed Wuchang fish captures the authentic flavor of the Yangtze River. Mianyang's three steamed dishes encapsulate the freshness of the Yangtze and Han rivers, Xiangyang beef noodles ignite the spirit of the ancient city, and Qianjiang's braised crayfish leads the way in late-night dining. From street food to banquet delicacies, every bite is a gift from the mountains and rivers, a testament to the rich culture and traditions of Hubei, showcasing the profound charm of Hubei cuisine.

◆ Hot Dry Noodles 热干面

Wuhan hot dry noodles, with their chewy alkaline noodles, rich and fragrant sesame sauce, and garnished with diced radish and chopped scallions, are an unforgettable breakfast staple etched into the bones of Wuhan people.



◆ Pork Rib and Lotus Root Soup 排骨藕汤

Selected soft and tender lotus roots from Honghu Lake and fresh pork ribs are simmered over low heat for several hours until the lotus roots are tender and the soup is thick. The aroma of the meat is infused with the sweetness of the lotus roots, creating a warm, mellow, and comforting home-style flavor that is a staple on the tables of people in Hubei.



◆ Steamed Wuchang Fish 清蒸武昌鱼

Steamed Wuchang Fish, a famous dish from Hubei province, is made with carefully selected fresh river fish. The fish is enhanced with scallions and ginger, and then steamed over high heat to lock in its freshness. The flesh is tender, white, and flavorful without any fishy taste, making it an unmissable delicacy from the Yangtze River for any banquet.



◆ Xiangyang Beef Noodles 襄阳牛肉面

Xiangyang beef noodles, glistening with red oil, feature chewy alkaline noodles and tender, flavorful beef chunks, a blend of numbing spiciness and savory aroma, making it the vibrant, lively dish of the ancient city's mornings.



◆ Qianjiang Braised Crayfish 潜江油焖小龙虾

Qianjiang, known as the "Hometown of Crayfish in China," boasts a signature dish: freshwater crayfish braised in a secret sauce and beer, resulting in a glossy, oily sheen. The crayfish meat is firm and juicy, with a delightful blend of savory and spicy flavors—a truly satisfying taste for summer nights out.



◆ Huangzhou Dongpo Pork 黄州东坡肉

Huangzhou Dongpo Pork, originating from Su Shi's creation during his exile in Huangzhou, is a refined delicacy among the famous dishes of Hubei. It uses carefully selected pork belly with a perfect balance of fat and lean meat, slowly braised with Shaoxing wine and rock sugar. The result is an enticingly bright red color, tender yet not greasy meat that melts in your mouth. The aroma of the meat infused with the fragrance of the wine creates a fusion of everyday life and cultural refinement in every bite, showcasing the culinary elegance of Huangzhou over the past thousand years.



◆ Xiaogan Rice Wine 孝感米酒

Xiaogan rice wine is made from carefully selected glutinous rice using traditional methods. It has a sweet and mellow aroma, and the rice is soft, sticky, and long-lasting. It warms the heart and stomach and is the authentic sweet and fragrant taste of the people of Hubei.
