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
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## Brief

Folk songs and lively dances abound, while a massive rope-pulling competition unites people in spirit. The Dunhuang dances, replicas of murals, are vibrant and lifelike. The painted sculptures and murals of the Mogao Grottoes and the ancient smiles of Maijishan Grottoes bear the imprint of cultural exchange. The beef noodles on the streets are rich and flavorful, while hand-pulled mutton and donkey meat noodles offer a taste of everyday life. Between the Gobi Desert and the oases, the unique humanistic warmth of Gansu shines through.

## Sights

### Mogao Caves 莫高窟



The Mogao Caves, also known as the Caves of a Thousand Buddhas, are located southeast of Dunhuang. Construction began during the Eastern Jin and Sixteen Kingdoms period, and they are a world-renowned Buddhist art site. The scenic area consists of a digital exhibition center and the caves, and operates on a combined ticket and reservation system, with a daily limit of 6,000 visitors. Visitors must first watch two exclusive films, then take a shuttle bus for a guided tour of 8-10 caves (approximately one hour), and finally return to the digital center by bus.

Open year-round from 07:30 to 18:00

## Transportation

- By bus: Please go to the opposite side of the Silk Road Yiyuan Hotel and take bus number 12. The fare is 8 yuan, and the journey takes 30 minutes.
- By taxi: It is approximately 9 kilometers from the city center to the Digital Exhibition Center.

## Travel Season

☉ Dunhuang has a temperate continental climate; May to October is the peak tourist season, and tourists are advised to travel during off-peak times.

## 📍 Zhangye Danxia National Geological Park 张掖七彩丹霞旅游景区



Zhangye Danxia National Geological Park is located on the northern foothills of the Qilian Mountains. It is a world geopark and a national 5A-level scenic area with 7 viewpoints and more than 30 scenic spots. It is a composite area of colorful hills and Danxia landforms with distinctive landscape features and is being developed into an international tourist destination for western China, focusing on vacation and scientific research.

## Opening Hours

07:30-17:00 year-round

## Transportation

● Take a bus from Zhangye West Bus Station to either Sunan County or Linze County. There are direct buses from Zhangye West Bus Station to Danxia Park; simply get off at the park entrance.

Linze Danxia is accessed from the west entrance, while Sunan Danxia is accessed from the east entrance. During the National Day holiday, it's recommended to hire a car to visit Binggou in the morning and Qicai Danxia in the afternoon.

## Travel Season

☉ The best time to appreciate Danxia landforms is after rain, when the colors become even more vibrant and bright after being moistened by the rain.

### ③ Mingsha Mountain and Crescent Lake 鸣沙山月牙泉



Mingsha Mountain and Crescent Lake, located south of Dunhuang city, are renowned as a "desert wonder" and are a symbol of Dunhuang. Surrounded by sand dunes, Crescent Lake's unique topography causes sand to flow uphill during windstorms, preventing it from being buried and earning it the nickname "Eye of the Desert." The sand dunes, formed by shifting sands, are spectacular and undulating. It's recommended to visit in the afternoon to avoid the heat and enjoy the sunset. The scenic area offers activities such as camel riding and sandboarding; the sand dunes make a sound when sandboarding, hence the name "Mingsha Mountain" (meaning "sand dunes").

#### Transportation

- By bus: Take bus route 3 in Dunhuang city center to the last stop, which will take you to the scenic area entrance.
- By taxi: Take a taxi from the city center; the fare is approximately 15 yuan, and the journey takes about 10 minutes.

#### Travel Season

⊙ This area has a typical extremely arid continental climate, with frequent winds and sandstorms; due to its unique environment, it is recommended to choose May to October as the best time to travel.

### ④ Jiayuguan Fortress 嘉峪关关城



Jiayuguan Fortress is located 5 kilometers west of Jiayuguan City. It is the western section of the Ming Great Wall and a local cultural relic scenic area. A combined ticket is required to visit, and visitors can walk or rent a car. The scenic area includes the Black Mountain Stone Sculpture Group, the Great Wall Museum, and the Nine-Eyed Spring Lake. The fortress features diverse architecture, and climbing the walls offers views of the Qilian Mountains and the Gobi Desert.


### Transportation

- By bus: Take bus route 4 or 6 and get off at Guancheng Scenic Area. It is within walking distance.

### Travel Season

☉ The best time to visit Jiayuguan Fortress is from May to October. The area has a temperate arid climate with significant annual temperature variations. The average annual temperature is about 6°C, and the annual precipitation is over 80 mm. January sees the coldest temperature, reaching -28.6°C, while July sees the hottest, reaching 38°C. Mid-July hosts the Jiayuguan International Gliding Festival, featuring exciting performances and competitions. October is ideal for climbing the July 1st Glacier; sunglasses, sunscreen, and hiking boots are essential.

### 📍 Yadan National Geopark 雅丹国家地质公园



Dunhuang Yadan National Geological Park, also known as the Devil City, is located 180 kilometers northwest of Dunhuang in the Gobi Desert. It's a major scenic spot on the western route of Dunhuang, characterized by its fantastical and spectacular Yadan landforms, and is a prime location for photography in the evening. The park is divided into north and south routes. Visitors can take a shuttle bus to the north route or a 4x4 off-road vehicle to explore the south route.

**Recommended play time: 3 hours**

### Opening Hours

Open year-round from 08:00 to 16:30

### Transportation

- Driving route: The distance from Dunhuang to Yumenguan is nearly 100 kilometers, about a 1-hour drive. From Yumenguan, travel west along the ancient Shule River Valley.

- Public transport route: City bus – Yadan bus, passing through Dunhuang Ancient City, Western Thousand Buddha Caves, the Han Great Wall, and Yumenguan.


### Travel Season

☉ This area has a typical extremely arid continental climate, with frequent winds and sandstorms; due to its unique environment, it is recommended to choose May to October as the best time to travel.

### Tips

Yardang landforms are easy to get lost in, and the climate is harsh, so you need to bring sun protection, water, and clothing.

## ⑥ Yumenguan Ruins 玉门关遗址



Yumen Pass is the core area of the Silk Road World Cultural Heritage site, with the "one pass and two cities" as its core ruins, showcasing the military defense wisdom of the Han Dynasty. Xiaofangpan City and Hecang City each have historical value, and the Han Great Wall and beacon towers form a three-dimensional defense network. The ruins in the Gobi Desert tell the desolate story of "Spring breeze never reaches Yumen Pass".

### Address

Located 80 kilometers northwest of Dunhuang City, Jiuquan City, on the Gobi Desert 酒泉市敦煌市城西北80公里戈壁滩上

**Recommended play time: 2 hours**

### Opening Hours

07:30-18:00 year-round

### Transportation

- Chartered car: The distance from Dunhuang to Yumenguan is about 90 kilometers, connected by a desert highway, which is generally passable by car. Currently, there is no direct public transportation; it is recommended to charter a car or find a local travel agency. Chartered car fees are around 300 yuan, while taxis range from 600 to 1000 yuan.
- Public bus: Take the city bus to Yumenguan, Yangguan, or the Yardang landform area; the fare is 76 yuan per person.

### Travel Season

- ◎ This area has a typical extremely arid continental climate, with frequent winds and sandstorms. It is recommended to choose May to travel between October as the best time.

## ⑦ Yangguan Scenic Area 阳关景区



Yangguan Scenic Area, located 70 kilometers southwest of Dunhuang, is a 4A-level scenic area. Originally built during the reign of Emperor Wu of the Western Han Dynasty, it is famous for a poem by Wang Wei and is an important cultural relic of the Silk Road and the Great Wall. The scenic area is dotted with ancient ruins, and its core group of Han-style architectural complexes boasts rich collections. It also offers unique recreational and educational experiences.

Yangguan Town, Dunhuang City, Jiuquan City, Gansu Province 甘肃省酒泉市敦煌市阳关镇

**Recommended play time: 3 hours**

### **Recommended play time: 4 hours**

#### **Opening Hours**

Closed from 8:30 to 18:00 from March 17th to December 31st;

closed all day from January 1st to March 16th.

#### **Transportation**

- Chartering a car: Chartering a car or sharing a car is available, including 7-seater business vans. Taking the bus is also an option; it's on the same route as Yumenguan and Yardang landforms, costing 76 yuan per person, with hotel pick-up and drop-off.

- Bus: Take a public bus from Dunhuang City Bus Station to Nanhu Township. Board the bus in front of the Shazhou Yangguan Hotel and get off at the Yangguan intersection, then walk for 30 minutes.

#### **Travel Season**

☉ The best time to visit is from May to October each year.

#### **Gandan Saichi Monastery 甘丹赛赤寺**



Ganden Serkhang Monastery is located in Gansu Province and was founded in 1748, the Year of the Earth Dragon according to the Tibetan calendar. It is a large monastery of the Gelug school of Tibetan Buddhism. The monastery currently preserves more than ten buildings, including the main assembly hall, the Maitreya Hall, and the Golden Roof Hall, and also houses five major colleges, including those for doctrinal studies and tantric studies.

#### **Transportation**

- It is recommended to travel to the destination by hiring a car or driving yourself from Langmusi.

#### **Binggou Danxia Scenic Area 冰沟丹霞景区**



The area is dominated by red palace-style Danxia landforms. While the colors are uniform, the shapes are unique and the scale is spectacular. It was developed relatively late and has fewer tourists, allowing for quiet sightseeing. The highlight of the scenic area is the Da Xitian area, accessible by sightseeing bus, which takes about half a day to complete.

- You can only get there by car or chartered car. The price for chartering a car to Linze Scenic Area or Sunan Scenic Area will be increased by 20-30 yuan.

## 📍 Pingshan Lake Grand Canyon 平山湖大峡谷



Pingshan Lake Grand Canyon, located 56 kilometers from Zhangye City, Gansu Province, is a national 4A-level scenic area that integrates canyon exploration, geological research, and other experiences. Its magnificent scenery rivals Zhangjiajie and Colorado, and its geological value is extremely high. It is a highlight of the Qinghai-Gansu Grand Loop, pristine and majestic, a haven for both natural and spiritual adventure.

## Opening Hours

07:30-21:00 year-round

## Transportation


- You can drive to Pingshan Lake Grand Canyon. It's about 50 minutes and 56 kilometers from Zhangye city center along the Zhang'a Highway. Parking is free at the scenic area.

- There are direct buses and commuter buses departing from the city center at various times. You can also hire a car or take a taxi.

## Travel Season

- 🕒 The best time to visit Pingshan Lake Grand Canyon is from May to October. Spring and autumn have cool and pleasant weather, summer is lush and green, autumn is colorful with red sandstone, and winter is cold and the scenery is sparse. Visiting during this period will provide a great experience for sightseeing and adventure.

## 11 Zhangye Giant Buddha Temple 张掖大佛寺



Zhangye Giant Buddha Temple, located in Zhangye City, has a history of over 900 years since its founding in the Western Xia Dynasty. It is a local landmark, famous for its large indoor clay reclining Buddha. The temple also includes earthen pagodas, the Shanxi Guild Hall, and other buildings. A walking tour takes about 1-2 hours. The temple houses exquisite sculptures, murals, and precious Buddhist scriptures.

**Recommended play time: 2 hours**

### Opening Hours

Open year-round from 08:30 to 18:00


### Transportation

- Zhangye Giant Buddha Temple is located in Zhangye city. You can take bus routes 1, 11, or 13 to the Giant Buddha Temple Cultural Square stop and walk there. A taxi in the city costs about 6 yuan. There is free parking available for those driving. It is also conveniently located on foot, close to the bustling city center.

### Travel Season

- ◎ The Great Buddha Temple is primarily an indoor attraction, so it can be visited year-round. However, it's best to avoid spring due to the frequent sandstorms and dry weather. Summer is the next best time, as Zhangye gets quite hot in the summer, so you'll need to bring plenty of water. Autumn is the best season, and winter, when the temple is covered in snow, is also a great time to visit.

## 12 Mati Temple Grottoes 马蹄寺石窟群



Mati Temple boasts a magnificent complex of grotto temples and stone caves, blending Han and Tibetan Buddhist architecture, and preserving ancient relics such as the hoofprint of a celestial horse and Yuan Dynasty murals. Currently, only the North Temple is open to the public, with the Thousand Buddha Cave and the Thirty-Three Heavens Buddha Cave being the main attractions. The latter is a seven-story core building carved into the mountainside, and visitors can also experience the unique nomadic life of the Yugur ethnic group.

### Opening Hours

8:00-18:00

### Transportation

- There are direct buses from Zhangye South Bus Station to Mati Temple, but the departure schedule is not fixed. After arriving at the Mati Temple scenic area, walk uphill along the road for 3km to reach the temple.

### Travel Season

☉ The best time to visit the Mati Temple Grottoes is from May to October.

Spring and autumn offer pleasant weather, with the grottoes reflecting the surrounding mountain scenery; summer is serene and cool; autumn brings vibrant colors to the forests; and winter is tranquil with fewer crowds. Each season offers its own unique charm, making it suitable for both prayer and historical exploration.

### 15 Lanzhou Danxia Waterfall Scenic Area 兰州水墨丹霞旅游景区



Lanzhou Danxia Waterfall is a key cultural tourism project of the province and city. It is located on the banks of the Yellow River, 13 kilometers from downtown Lanzhou and 30 kilometers from Zhongchuan Airport. The Danxia landform has one of the largest areas in China. It is dominated by the Hongshan Bay landform and has unique landscapes. The scenic area has 7 viewing platforms and other sightseeing spots.

### Address

Xinghua Village, Shuping Town, Yongdeng County, Lanzhou City, Gansu Province 甘肃省兰州市永登县树屏镇杏花村

**Recommended play time: 3 days**

### Opening Hours

09:00-17:00 (Off-season) (October 10th - March 31st of the following year, Monday-Friday)

08:30-17:00 (Peak season) (April 1st - October 9th, Monday-Friday)

### Transportation

- For those driving, the S101 highway offers several routes to Lanzhou Danxia National Geological Park, a convenient 13-kilometer drive from the city center.

Alternatively, one can take bus N125 from the city center and transfer to a shuttle bus to the scenic area. Regular tourist shuttle buses are also available from the passenger transport center.

**14 Gansu Provincial Museum**  
甘肃省博物馆



The Gansu Provincial Museum is located in Qilihe District, Lanzhou. It boasts a rich collection that integrates cultures from the Western Regions, Central Plains, and Tibetan areas, including national treasures such as the Flying Horse of Gansu and the Brick Carving of the Messenger. The museum has three floors with multiple themed exhibition halls, and a visit typically takes about half a day. It also features a café area and offers services such as guided tours, wheelchair rentals, and luggage storage.

**Transportation**

- Within the city, you can take bus routes 1, 18, 31, 50, 53, 58, 59, 71, 76, 77, 103, 106, 129, 132, 134, or 137 and get off at the [Qilihe Bridge] stop, then walk from there.

- Alternatively, you can take bus routes 31, 32, 53, 58, K102, or K58 (peak hour express) to the Provincial Museum (bus stop) and then walk from there.

**Tips**

- ⦿ Reservations are required to visit the Gansu Provincial Museum. It is open from 9:00 to 17:00 and closes at 16:30. Flash photography and touching exhibits are prohibited in the exhibition halls. Children and the elderly must be accompanied by a designated person. Luggage can be stored free of charge.

 **Eating**

Gansu cuisine blends Silk Road culture with the flavors of various ethnic groups, with noodles and beef and mutton as its core, showcasing the bold and robust nature of Northwest Chinese food. Lanzhou beef noodles are renowned throughout the country, emphasizing the authentic flavor of "one clear, two white, three red, four green, and five yellow" (a traditional Gansu specialty). Hand-pulled mutton is tender and not gamey, a classic hearty dish of Gansu, while liangpi (cold skin noodles) is sour, spicy, chewy, and refreshing. Each region has its own unique characteristics: Zhangye stir-fried noodles are full of local flavor, Dunhuang donkey meat noodles are chewy and flavorful, and Tianshui jiangshui noodles are tangy and appetizing. Sweet fermented rice, gray beans, and fried dough cakes are sweet and delicious, with a blend of sour, spicy, salty, and savory flavors, embodying the rich local flavor of Gansu.

◆ **Lanzhou Beef Noodles 兰州牛肉面**

The core principles are "one clear, two white, three red, four green, and five yellow," meaning the soup is clear and flavorful, the meat is tender and the noodles are gluten, and the flavor is sour, spicy, and mellow.



◆ **Dongxiang Hand-Pulled Lamb 东乡手抓羊肉**

Dongxiang hand-pulled mutton is a classic hearty dish from Gansu. It is made by simmering carefully selected Dongxiang mutton, resulting in tender, non-gamey meat with a rich and savory flavor. It is served freshly cut and eaten immediately, showcasing the bold and authentic taste of Northwest cuisine.



◆ **Dunhuang Donkey Meat Noodles**

**敦煌驴肉黄面**

Dunhuang donkey meat noodles are a classic specialty of Dunhuang. The noodles are hand-made, chewy and smooth, while the donkey meat is braised until flavorful, fragrant and tender. Paired with a secret sauce, the taste is rich and complex, making it a must-try Silk Road delicacy.



◆ **Jingning Roast Chicken 静宁烧鸡**

Jingning roasted chicken is a classic dish from Jingning, Gansu Province, and a provincial-level intangible cultural heritage food. It is made by selecting local free-range chickens, using spices, and braising them in an aged broth. The chickens are golden red in color, tender, and fall off the bone, with a fresh and fragrant flavor that is not greasy.



◆ **Longxi Cured Meat 陇西腊肉**

Longxi cured pork is a classic delicacy from Longxi, Gansu. It is made from selected fresh pork through a curing and smoking process, resulting in a reddish-brown, glossy appearance, a rich and savory flavor, and a fatty yet not greasy taste. It is a must-have specialty on the local dining table.



#### ◆ Wuwei Three-Piece Meat Noodles 武威三套车

Wuwei Three-Course Meal is a classic and distinctive culinary combination from Wuwei, Gansu Province. It consists of noodles, braised meat, and Fu tea. The noodles are chewy, the braised meat is rich and flavorful, and the Fu tea helps to cut through the richness. The flavors blend together perfectly, making it a must-try Northwest delicacy in the area.



#### ◆ Jiangshui Noodles 浆水面

Jiangshui noodles are a representative home-style noodle dish of Gansu, especially famous for their Tianshui flavor, while Longnan, Dingxi, and other places also have their own unique preparation methods. The core Jiangshui (fermented liquid) is made from seasonal vegetables such as celery, bitter lettuce, and alfalfa, and has a sour, fragrant, and refreshing taste that is both appetizing and helps to cut through any greasiness. It is served with chewy, hand-rolled or pulled noodles, topped with the Jiangshui broth, and can be seasoned with scallions, chili oil, or pickled vegetables according to taste. This bowl of noodles is refreshing and delicious, perfect for cooling down and relieving fatigue in the sweltering summer.



#### ◆ JLiangpi 酿皮子

Liangpi is a classic cold dish well-known throughout Gansu and Northwest China, with Lanzhou Gaodan Liangpi being the most famous. Made from high-quality flour, the gluten is extracted and steamed to create thin, chewy, and translucent noodles, which are then cut into strips and served with the springy gluten. It's drizzled with a secret-recipe vinegar and spicy red oil, and seasoned with minced garlic, mustard, sesame paste, cucumber shreds, and other condiments. The result is a tangy, spicy, and savory dish with a chewy and smooth texture, offering a rich and layered flavor. It's refreshing and appetizing, a must-have summer treat for Northwest Chinese, and can be found everywhere on the streets.



### ◆ Sweet Fermented Rice 甜醅子

Sweet fermented rice is a traditional local snack highly representative of Gansu and Northwest China. Made primarily from oats and highland barley, it is produced through washing, steaming, mixing with yeast, and natural fermentation. The finished product features plump, chewy grains infused with the mellow aroma of rice wine. It has a pleasantly sweet and sour taste with a refreshing aftertaste, and it helps to cut through greasiness and aid digestion. It can be enjoyed hot or cold, and is refreshingly cool when chilled. A classic choice for cooling off in the summer and satisfying cravings in Northwest China, it can be found everywhere on the streets and alleys, embodying the simple, everyday life of Gansu.


